NARRATIVE

About 7:18 PM on Thursday, August 25, 2022, Members of the B-3 Anti-Crime Unit consisting of Officers J. O'Brien, M. Miller (CK01), under the direct supervision of Sgt P. Bissonnette (C907) and Sgt Det J. Burrows (C983) conducted a firearm investigation in the area of 950 Blue Hill Ave (Harambe Park) resulting in the arrest of suspect Keondre Tyler Barrett.

Based on information gleaned from an active firearm investigation, the officers became aware of an individual believed to be in possession of illegal firearm in area of Harambe Park and the Sportsmen's Tennis and Enrichment Center. The area has been plagued by a significant amount of gun violence which has resulted in shots fired, people shot, and homicides.

The area centered around this investigation is a large community park and sports complex which abuts the Blue Hill Boys and Girls Club, the Perkins Community Center, the Joseph Lee School and the Franklin Field Housing Development. The area is specifically designed for families, children, and the youth within the community and utilized for large community events, parades, and sporting events. Harambe Park, which runs between Blue Hill Ave and Talbot Ave has also been the center for gatherings for yearly parades and events such as J'ouvert and the Caribbean Festival.

The officers were aware that Caribbean Festival Weekend (which was within 24 hours of this incident) draws thousands of families to the area to enjoy a weekend of fun festivities and family gatherings, but also has drawn gang and gun violence.

The officers received information that an individual described as a tall black male wearing a camouflage hooded jacket, blue sweatpants with white stripes, and white sneakers was believed to be in possession of an illegal firearm concealed in his left jacket pocket. The officers were made aware that the individual was initially observed inside Harambe Park with a small group and had entered a dark gray sedan and was positioned in the rear passenger seat of the vehicle. The vehicle was parked in the entrance way to 950 Blue Hill Ave (Sportsmen's Tennis and Enrichment Center) and was positioned closest to Blue Hill Ave.

On this night 8/25/22, observations were made that the area of Harambe Park had 40-50 kids and family members playing on the playground, the basket ball court, and leisurely walking throughout the park. The officers noted that the weather was 80 degrees and the majority of people were wearing shorts and tee shirts. The officers were aware through their experience in investigating and apprehending individuals who possess illegal firearms, that hooded sweatshirts/jackets/heavy clothing are commonly used concealment garments for individuals in possession of illegal firearms.

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Armed with the aforementioned information, the officers made their way to 950 Blue Hill and initiated their investigation. The officers were operating an unmarked Black Ford Explorer police cruiser with low profile emergency lights affixed to the interior and exterior of the vehicle. The members of the B-3 Anti-Crime Unit entered the driveway to 950 Blue Hill Ave and observed the suspect vehicle (MA Reg [REDACTED]) a dark gray Toyota Camry exited their cruiser dressed in plain clothes wearing outer ballistic carrier vests with "Boston Police" insignia affixed to the front and rear of their vests and badges prominently displayed out their outermost garments.

Officer Miller and Sgt Bissonnette approached the driver's side of the vehicle, Officer O'Brien approached the passenger side of the vehicle. The officers noted the vehicles heavy tint and the driver/registered owner, later identified as [REDACTED] rolled down the windows. The front passenger was a female, later identified as [REDACTED]

Officer O'Brien observed the target of the investigation, later identified as Keondre Tyler Barrett, was seated in the rear right passenger wearing the camouflage hooded jacket, blue sweatpants with white stripes and white sneakers. Officer O'Brien observed that Barrett was sweating profusely, and his breath was very rapid and shallow while seated. Officer O'Brien opened the rear right passenger door and asked Barrett if he had any weapons on him, which he looked down toward the left side of his jacket and stated "no". Officer O'Brien conducted a pat-frisk of Barrett's left jacket pocket and immediately felt a heavy/hard metallic object consisted with the weight and shape of a firearm.

Officer O'Brien alerted his partners to the presence of a gun by shouting [REDACTED] Now joined by Officer Miller and Sgt Bissonnette, Officer O'Brien safely removed a silver KHAR Arms .45 Caliber firearm from Barrett's left jacket pocket. Officer Miller and Sgt Bissonnette then quickly and safely placed Barrett into handcuffs without incident.

A pat-frisk of [REDACTED] as well as [REDACTED] vehicle was conducted which yielded negative results [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were later FIO'd and released.

Officer Miller demanded Barrett's MA license to carry which he stated "I don't".

Sgt Det Burrows (C983) along with B-3 Detective Linehan (C803) photographed and processed the scene.

The recovered firearm was a KHAR Arms .45 Caliber semi-automatic with (1) live cartridge in the chamber and (5) live cartridges in the magazine. The firearms serial number was obliterated and unable to be identified. The firearm was processed at District B-3 and secured in the B-3 gun locker.

Barrett was transported to District B-3 by Officer Hernandez/Rodriguez where he was booked and processed by Officer Freeman.

Keondre Barrett will be charged in Dorchester District Court with the following:

5. 269.11B Defaced firearm serial number

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ADA [REDACTED] was notified.
