**NARRATIVE**

About 8:58 PM on Tuesday December 13<sup>th</sup> 2022, Officers Turner and Coyne made an on-site firearm arrest of Admilson Pereira, at 309 Bowdoin St.

The Officers were assigned to plain clothes with their badges prominently displayed on their outermost garments and wearing outer ballistic vests with Boston Police identifying panels visible. The officers were operating an unmarked cruiser with low-profile emergency lights affixed to the interior and exterior making it readily identifiable as a police cruiser. Officer Coyne was positioned in the driver's seat, and Officer Turner was positioned in the front passenger seat.

Officers were in the area of Bowdoin St. and Adams St. having just concluded a traffic stop at 33 Adams St. Officers are well aware that historically the Bowdoin St. neighborhood has been plagued by gun violence particularly due to rival gang feuds.

Officers, now making their way back towards District 3, were traveling off of Adams St. turning onto Bowdoin St., when their attention was drawn to two male individuals who were crossing Bowdoin St. towards Percival St. The two individuals were walking in tandem, one behind the other, at a fast pace. The first male, later identified as the suspect ADMILSON PEREIRA, was walking in an unnatural way, with his right arm pinned to his side, the left arm however was swinging freely. The second individual later identified as [REDACTED], was walking directly behind the suspect with both of his hands in front of his waistband, and appeared to be wearing a black fanny pack across his chest.

Both males appeared to take note of the Officers and became hypervigilant to their presence, as they began quickening their pace, in fact [REDACTED] started to jog to catch up to Pereira. As he did he looked back at the Officers direction. Officers in order to further observe the individuals turned left onto Percival St. As they did so they observed that Pereira, was still walking with his right arm pinned to his side, with his right hand inside of his pocket, and left arm continued to swing freely.

Officers pulled along side both parties, who were now walking on the driver's side of their vehicle, and began engaging in casual conversation without exiting their cruiser. Officer Coyne stated "what's up" and Pereira stated "what's up" but continued walking and looking straight ahead. Officer Coyne then stated "its pretty cold out" Periera, responded "yup" and again continued to walk straight ahead. Officer Coyne noticed that there appeared to be a weighted object in the suspect front right pocket (referred to over the radio as "left front pocket" due to Officers looking at the suspects behind them). As the Officers continued to drive past the individuals, Officer Coyne continued to observe them, specifically Pereira, and stated to Officer Turner "I think I can see the slide to a gun in his pocket". Officer Coyne then slowed the cruisers speed and asked "do you see it?" Officer Turner stated "no", which was due to his positioning in the cruiser. Officer Coyne then began to pull the cruiser over to the left side of the street in order investigate further, at which point both individuals turned around completely and began to walk in the opposite direction back towards Bowdoin St. As Officer began to conduct a three-point turn the two parties then took off running.

Based on the Officers observations of the the two individuals, specifically Pereira, walking in an unnatural manor with his right arm pinned to his body, their hyper vigilance to the Officer's presence, the high level of firearm activity and violence in the area, the gang fueds surrounding the neighborhood specifically regarding Adams St.'s fued with ATM (Active trap Members), (two shootings near 10 Helen St. in the last week, their behavior when Officer first spoke to them, Officer Coyne's observations of the possible outline of a firearm in Pereir's pocket, and their flight as Officers attempted to speak with them furhter.

Officer activated their emergency lights and sirens and began following the suspects, who had turned right onto Bowdoin St. making their way onto Adams St. Officer caught up to the individuals who turned around and ran onto Bowdoin St. Officers again caught up to the suspects on Bowdoin, who then turned back and ran up Percival St. Officers cut the suspects off on Percival St. and exited their cruiser and began pursuing the suspects, on foot as they continued to flee, back towards Bowdoin St.

Officers continued to pursue the suspects, as they now entered the parking lot of the Church at 309 Bowdoin St. and began to split up. Officer Coyne was able to apprehend Pereira, as he tripped and fell to the ground. As he fell to the ground, he landed awkwardly due to his right hand still being inside of his pocket. He then turned the right side of his body, away from Officer Coyne shielding his right pocket from him. Based on the observations made by the Officers, they were in fear that either one, or both of the suspects were in possession of a firearm. Officer Coyne then began to pat frisk the outside of the suspect right pocket and immediately felt what he knew to be the slide to a firearm based off of his training and experience.

Officer Coyne then removed a black and blue firearm from Pereira’s pocket, and placed it a safe distance away from the suspect, in order to safely place him into handcuffs due to being alone with him at that point in time. Officer Coyne demanded to see Pereira’s License to Carry a firearm and he stated “no I found it”.

Officer Turner who was also in fear that either suspect may have been in possession of a firearm ordered ██████ to show him his hands ██████ complied and began to turn around as Officer Turner caught up to him. ██████ was then placed into handcuffs and frisked for weapons to no avail. It should be noted that there was a large language barrier between Officers and ██████ and he primarily spoke with the C435 (Fernandes) on scene.

The C907 (Sgt. Bissonnette) and C908 (Sgt. Foote) responded to the scene as well as the C808 (Det. Seoane) and C802 (Det. Dellascio) who processed the scene and took custody of the firearm, which was a black and blue colored Kel-Tech 9mm semi-automatic pistol, with 9 rounds in the magazine and no rounds in the chamber.

Both suspects were placed into separate BPD Cruisers vehicles, ██████ being a juvenile was transported to his Aunts house, located at ██████ by Officers Fernandes and Turner. He was left in the custody of his cousin ██████. Pereira was then transported back to B3 by the C202F (Martniez/ Thornton) without incident, and booked by booking Officer Rodriguez, and was charged with the following:

MGL. Ch. 269. 10 (a)- firearm without FID card, possess

MGL. Ch. 269. 10 (n)- firearm, carry without license loaded

MGL. Ch. 269. 10 (h)- ammunition without FID card, possess

It should be noted that Officer Lima (H102F) responded to B3 in order to read the suspect his Miranda warning.
