NARRATIVE

About, 12:35am, on Saturday December 31, 2022, members of the Youth Violence Strike Force, consisting of Officers Lekaditis, Stallings, and O'Brien (VK10), under the supervision of Sergeant Byrne (VK901), made an on-site arrest of Tamari Tubbs (DOB [REDACTED]), for firearm related offenses in front of 66 Kingsdale St, Dorchester.

Officers were dressed in plain clothes with badges prominently displayed on their outer clothing and operating an unmarked Boston Police Cruiser (#6553). Two out of the three officers were also wearing outer ballistic vests with "Boston Police" on the front and back. On this particular night, Officer Stallings was positioned in the driver's seat, Officer Lekaditis was positioned in the front passenger seat, and Officer O'Brien was positioned in the back right passenger seat.

Officers were on patrol on Erie St, stopped at the traffic light at the intersection of Washington St. While stopped at the traffic light, the officers observed a vehicle traveling in the opposite direction with excessively tinted windows.

The vehicle was a black Volvo XC-90 bearing MA Reg: [REDACTED], and continued traveling on Eire St towards Glenway St. The tint on the windows were excessive to the point where officers were unable to see the race, gender, or number of occupants inside the vehicle. Officers then turned around in order to initiate a traffic stop of the vehicle.

As Officers attempted to catch up to the vehicle, the officers observed the vehicle make a left turn from Erie St onto Glenway St. Officers then observed the vehicle to be traveling at a high rate of speed on Glenway St towards Harvard St. Officers then observed the vehicle make a left turn onto Harvard St and then a right turn onto Standish St. Officers observed, as they were catching up to the vehicle, that the vehicle had come to a stop in the travel lane on Standish St for several seconds. The vehicle then continued on West Park and then made a right turn onto Bernard St.

At this time, officers activated their emergency lights and siren on Bernard St near the intersection of Kingsdale St. The vehicle then made a left turn onto Kingsdale St and continued to travel towards Wales St. Officers noted that as the vehicle continued to travel on Kingsdale St, the vehicle did not appear to slow down, nor did any brake lights illuminate. The vehicle continued to travel straight for several hundred feet before eventually slowing down, at which point it continued roll forward before eventually coming to a complete stop on the left side of the street. This was concerning to the officers as they have made numerous firearm arrests where suspects take an extended period of time pull over and stop in order to conceal a firearm.

Officers then exited their cruiser and approached the vehicle. It should be noted that as the officers approached the vehicle, they still could not ascertain the race, gender, or number of occupants inside the vehicle due to the excessively dark tint on the windows. Officer Stallings approached the driver's side of the vehicle while Officers Lekaditis and O'Brien approached the passenger side. Officer Stallings then spoke with the operator, later identified as Tamari Tubbs (DOB [REDACTED]), who was wearing a hooded sweatshirt with the hood on and a full facemask covering above his nose. Officers Stallings informed Tubbs that he was being stopped for excessive tint and instructed him to roll down the windows of the vehicle due to the other officers being unable to see in the vehicle. Tubbs then provided Officer Stallings with his driver's license. It should be noted that Officer Stallings is familiar with Tubbs from a previous incident in which three illegally possessed firearms were recovered during a traffic stop. (I182095167) It should also be noted that this particular area has seen an uptick in firearm activity and firearm violence over the past several months, to include but not limited to shots fired and persons shot incidents.

Based on the amount of time it took for Mr. Tubbs to pull over for officers and his history around firearms feared that Mr. Tubbs was in possession of a firearm. Officers asked Tubbs to exit the vehicle, while Officer Lekaditis opened the driver's door using the inside handle. As Officer Lekaditis was opening the door, Tubbs attempted to block the officer's hand from opening the door. Once the door was open, Tubbs then attempted to pull away from the officers. Tubbs was instructed not to pull away and instructed to step out of the vehicle. Tubbs refused to exit the vehicle and told officers that they needed a supervisor present in order to remove him from the vehicle. Officers instructed Tubbs to step out of the vehicle several more times all of which he refused and even stated "hell no". Officers informed Tubbs that he would be removed from the vehicle at which time he stepped out of the vehicle on his own.

Officers then pat-frisked Tubbs which resulted in no weapons located. Officers then performed a frisk of the vehicle. During a frisk of the vehicle, the officers attention was drawn to the center console where the back portion of the center console detached from the front portion and exposed a covered compartment. It should be noted that the officers have recovered several illegally possessed firearms from natural voids inside vehicles. Officers then opened the compartment, immediately revealing the grip portion of a firearm. At this time, Tubbs was placed in handcuffs and Officer Lekaditis demanded to see his License to a Carry a Firearm which he responded that he he did not have a firearm. Tubbs was later transported to District B-3 to be booked by the C111A (Coleman/Chardeza).

Sergeant Byrne (VK901), Officers Stevens, Sanchez, and Trooper Alldredge (VK16), and Officers Calabrese, Osis and Lewis (CK01A) also assisted on scene. Detective Medina (VK805) responded to the scene, photographed the scene, and recovered the firearm. The vehicle was towed by Always Open (#30942). Tow Line notified (Crowley).

The firearm was a Smith & Wesson SD9VE 9mm handgun (serial #EDB1031) loaded with live 9mm cartridge in the chamber and 15 live 9mm cartridges in the magazine.
