NARRATIVE

About 5:03 P.M. on Monday, January 2, 2023, Officers Bertocchi, O'Brien and Kerrigan in the BK01F conducted a traffic stop at 44 Blue Hill Ave that resulted in the arrest of Ms. Dennise Rivera.

It should be noted that all three officers were dressed in plain clothes, with their vests displayed over their outermost garments, with patches that displayed "BOSTON POLICE" on the vest and their badges clearly displayed on their outermost garments. Officers were also operating an unmarked Boston Police cruiser 9539, which is a black Ford Explorer, equipped with emergency lights making it easily identifiable as a police vehicle. Officers assigned to B2 use this vehicle for all three shifts, meaning this vehicle responds to 911 calls throughout the shift, including the area of Blue Hill Avenue.

Officers were on Quincy Street, travelling towards Blue Hill Ave, prior to taking a right onto Blue Hill Ave towards Dudley Street, when Officer O'Brien, who was operating the vehicle, informed Officers that the vehicle stopped at the

red light on Blue Hill Ave did not have their headlights on. It should be noted that Officer O'Brien could not see the occupants, nor could he determine their race or gender as he was turning right onto Blue Hill, a public way in the City of Boston. Officer O'Brien turned right onto Blue Hill Ave and continued on Blue Hill Ave towards Dudley Street, before pulling to the right side of the road, opposite Savin Street. As Officers pulled over, the traffic light controlling the traffic on Blue Hill Ave turned from red to green and the vehicle without the lights on began travelling on Blue Hill Ave in the direction of Dudley Street. As the vehicle went by, Officer O'Brien read the license plate aloud while Officer Kerrigan conducted a CJIS query of plate (MA REG [REDACTED]), which showed the vehicle was registered to [REDACTED]. The CJIS query showed the vehicle did not have an Inspection Sticker (90/7) although it was registered on June 22, 2022.

The vehicle continued on Blue Hill Ave and when it was safe, Officer O'Brien pulled back into traffic. Officers were not immediately able to pull the vehicle over due to other vehicles travelling between the Officers unmarked cruiser and MA REG [REDACTED]. As the vehicle passed Moreland Street, Officers were able to activate their lights and sirens and the vehicle pulled over in front of 44 Blue Hill Ave.

Officers O'Brien and Bertocchi approached the operator's side of the vehicle while Officer Kerrigan approached the passenger side of the vehicle. Officer O'Brien asked the operator, later identified as Dennise Rivera, for her license to which she stated she did not have one. It should be noted that Ms. Rivera was wearing a silver puffy jacket with the hood pulled up over her head. Officer O'Brien asked Ms. Rivera if the vehicle was her vehicle to which she stated 'No' and the passenger, later identified as [REDACTED], stated "It's mine" and handed Officer O'Brien her license. Officer O'Brien asked Ms. Rivera for her name, which he entered into CJIS on his department work phone. The CJIS query showed that Denise Rivera ([REDACTED]) and resides at 18 Semont Street, Dorchester, had two active straight warrants. Officer O'Brien asked Ms. Rivera for her address, which she stated was 18 Semont Street. Due to the discrepancy in the date of birth for Ms. Rivera, the spelling of the first name Ms. Rivera provided (Dennise), the name on the warrants (Denise) and Ms. Rivera confirming the address on the warrants (18 Semont) was her current address, Officer O'Brien returned to the cruiser to further investigate the information provided and confirm the active warrants.

Once back at the cruiser, Officer O'Brien confirmed that Ms. Rivera's license status was 'SUSPENDED'. Officer O'Brien and Officer Bertocchi were back at the cruiser while Officer Kerrigan remained at the vehicle. Officer Kerrigan walked to the back of the vehicle and towards the cruiser to hear what Officer O'Brien was saying to him at which time Officer O'Brien confirmed the warrants, the status of Ms. Rivera's license and the fact she has an open case for possessing ammunition (2215CR004100) as well as a prior firearm arrest (2107CR000802).

Officer Bertocchi asked Ms. Rivera to exit the vehicle and he and Officer O'Brien placed Ms. Rivera under arrest. Officer Bertocchi walked Ms. Rivera to the Officers cruiser where she stood at the Officers front bumper, facing MA REG [REDACTED]. Officer Kerrigan requested a female Officer over the air to assist Officers with Ms. Rivera and the B452F (Gonzalez) informed operations that she would assist. While standing at the cruiser, Officer Bertocchi, using the outside of his hand, conducted a frisk of Ms. Rivera's outermost garments and when he pressed his hand against Ms. Rivera's front, left pants pocket, heard the sounds of plastic crinkling. Officer Bertocchi immediately recognized the sound, from his training and past narcotics arrests, as being consistent with a plastic baggy, often used to hold narcotics. Officer Bertocchi reached into Ms. Rivera's front left pocket and removed one large plastic bag, that contained one plastic baggy of multiple white, rock like substances, believed to be crack cocaine, one plastic baggy containing multiple blue pills, which Officer Bertocchi believed to be pressed Fentanyl pills as well as one, single blue pill. Officer Bertocchi secured the narcotics and read Ms. Rivera her Miranda Warnings from his Boston Police Miranda Card that was issued by the Boston Police Academy, which she stated she understood.

It should be noted that while Ms. Rivera was still at the front of the Officers cruiser, Officer O'Brien observed Ms. Rivera's eyes widen and a concerned expression come across her face as Officer O'Brien opened the back seat driver side door.

Shortly after Ms. Rivera was removed by Officers Bertocchi and O'Brien, Officer Kerrigan asked the owner of the vehicle, [REDACTED]. Officer Kerrigan removed [REDACTED] and while speaking with her, offered to get her jacket from the vehicle. It should be noted that there was a gold jacket on the passenger seat, where [REDACTED] was sitting. Officer Kerrigan grabbed the gold jacket on the passenger seat and asked [REDACTED], "Do you want this" to which she replied, "Yea". After Officer Kerrigan informed Ms. Rodrigues that Ms. Rivera was being placed under arrest, [REDACTED] informed Officer Kerrigan that she knew nothing about the drugs on Ms. Rivera's person.

The B452F (Gonzalez) and B660F (Baez-Saldana) arrived on scene. Both Officers were occupying the same cruiser (5575) which was also an unmarked vehicle. Officer Kerrigan then requested another marked vehicle to transport Ms. Rivera back to B2 for booking. The B455F (Cooper) responded, and Ms. Rivera was placed in the rear of his marked cruiser. Officer O'Brien, who returned to the Officers cruiser (9539) conducted a search of Ms. Dennise Rivera in Mark 43 and briefly read her firearm arrest (212024154). Officer O'Brien returned to MA REG [REDACTED] and informed Officers that in Ms. Rivera's prior firearm arrest, the firearm was located in a jacket in the vehicle. Officers observed multiple female clothing items throughout the vehicle. Officer O'Brien then opened the driver side rear door and, on the floor, behind the driver seat was a silver, puffy jacket. Officer O'Brien moved the jacket and immediately felt a weight inconsistent with a puffy jacket. Officer O'Brien then observed a black magazine inside of a tan colored firearm. Officer O'Brien said '269' and informed Officers on scene of the recovery of a firearm. Officer Kerrigan informed Officer Baez-Saldana to place [REDACTED] into handcuffs.

Officer Bertocchi then read Ms. Rivera her Miranda Warnings from his Boston Police Miranda Card that was issued by the Boston Police Academy for a second time, to which she stated she understood. Officer Bertocchi then demanded Ms. Rivera's license to carry a firearm which Ms. Rivera initially did not respond to Officer Bertocchi's demand. When asked again, Ms. Rivera inquired as to what firearm Officer Bertocchi was referring too. Officer Bertocchi advised Ms. Rivera as to the reason for the traffic stop of the motor vehicle and the reasons for her subsequent arrest. She was then advised that a firearm was recovered from the motor vehicle. Officer Bertocchi then inquired about the vehicle and Ms. Rivera informed Officer Bertocchi that she had been operating the vehicle for a couple of hours and just picked up [REDACTED]. Officer Bertocchi then asked Ms. Rivera again if the firearm belonged to her to which she nodded yes moving her head up and down.

Officer Kerrigan read [REDACTED] her Miranda Rights off of his department issued cell phone, using the departments 'Miranda Warning' located on the Home Page. Officer Kerrigan then demanded [REDACTED] license to carry a firearm to which [REDACTED] stated, "License to carry a firearm, I don't have a license to carry a firearm." Officer Kerrigan asked [REDACTED] if all of the property in her vehicle was hers to which she stated, "It's a combination." [REDACTED] confirmed some of the articles of clothing were laundry and then stated she wanted a lawyer.

The B913 (Sgt. Dervan), B803 (Det. Kennedy) and the B832 (Det. Gamble) responded and processed the scene.

The B455F (Cooper) transported Ms. Rivera back to B2 with the B452F (Gonzalez) in the front passenger seat. While Ms. Rivera was in the back of the police cruiser, Ms. Rivera stated, "Can I have my coat" to which Officer Gonzalez asked, "What color is your coat?" Ms. Rivera replied, "The silver jacket in the car." Both Officers had their body worn cameras on during the transport.

The firearm was found to be a Polymer 80, Glock 17, Model PF94DV2 with no serial number. The firearm was loaded with one round in the chamber and four rounds in the magazine. The magazines capacity is unknown due to how it is numbered.

It should be noted that while Officers were reviewing their Body Worn Camera footage of the incident, Officers observe Ms. Rivera wearing the silver, puffy jacket. Throughout the interaction, Ms. Rivera makes small, subtle movements in an attempt to take it off. Ms. Rivera is seen on camera with the jacket on, taking it off and placing it towards the center console. Body Worn Camera does not capture Ms. Rivera pushing the jacket onto the floor of the driver seat, where the jacket was discovered with the firearm inside of it.

Ms. Rivera was issued MA Citation T2394314 which was attached to her property.

Drugs logged in Drug Book 02-0004. Page 101.

Drug paperwork completed.

The crack cocaine weighed 18 grams.

Officers seized \$852.00 from Ms. Rivera
