**NARRATIVE**

About 1:50 PM on Thursday, 12/01/2022, Officers Adams, Harrington, and O'Toole, in the CK01D, conducted a traffic stop resulting in the on-site arrest of Ricardo Hamilton for firearm related offenses in the area of 10 Orlando Street in Mattapan.

Officers were operating unmarked Boston Police Cruiser #7532, an unmarked black Ford Explorer with low-profile lights affixed to the interior and exterior of the cruiser as well as a front push bar making it easily identifiable as a police cruiser. Officers were assigned to plain clothes, wearing outer ballistic vests with Boston Police identifying panels attached to the exterior and with Boston Police badges on their outermost garments. Officer Adams was operating cruiser #7532, Officer Harrington was in the front passenger seat, and Officer O'Toole was in the rear passenger area behind Officer Harrington.

Officers were on patrol in the area of Hiawatha Road and Blue Hill Ave, when they observed a vehicle (MA: [REDACTED], 2016 Chrysler 200) traveling from Norfolk Street onto Blue Hill Ave. Officers observed the vehicle to have excessive window tint on the front and back passenger windows as well as the rear windshield making them unable to determine the number of occupants inside or any of their personal identifying characteristics.

Officers are also aware that individuals will often utilize window tint as a means to conceal their identity from law enforcement and rivals.

Officers were stopped at the red light at Blue Hill Ave. and Hiawatha Rd. facing outbound. The vehicle in question was traveling from Norfolk Street through a green light going outbound onto Blue Hill Ave. Officers continued on Blue Hill Ave. behind the vehicle and observed it make a right hand turn onto Almont Street without using a turn signal. The vehicle then continued past Almont Park and made a left hand turn onto Orlando Street without using a turn signal again. Officers then activated their emergency lights and sirens to conduct a traffic stop for the multiple aforementioned violations.

The vehicle pulled to the left hand side of Orlando Street and came to an abrupt stop, partially blocking a driveway. The driver (later identified as the suspect, Ricardo Hamilton) then immediately exited the vehicle and shut the car door.

Officers instructed the suspect (Hamilton) to re-enter the vehicle so they could properly conduct the traffic stop. The suspect got back inside the vehicle but did not roll his window down until after Officers knocked on the window instructing him to do so.

Officers Adams and O'Toole were on the driver's side of the vehicle while Officer Harrington was on the passenger side. Officers explained to the suspect their concern about him exiting the vehicle and questioned why he would do so. The suspect stated that he had never been pulled over before. Officers asked again for the suspect's reasoning for exiting the car but the suspect was unable to give a logical answer and eventually put his hands up and shrugged his shoulders and stated, "I don't know."

Officers then requested the suspect's license and registration. The suspect retrieved both items and handed them to Officers. The suspect had a wide-eyed expression on his face at times and he appeared to be breathing rapidly, as Officers observed his chest to be rising and falling at a fast rate.

Officers then asked the suspect what his destination was on Orlando Street. The suspect stated, "Right here," and pointed further down the street. When asked again where specifically he was going, the suspect again pointed down Orlando Street and said he was "coming to chill," and but was unsure if there were any people in the area to chill with.

Orlando Street is a small dead-end road in Mattapan, approximately only 200 yards long, with less than ten houses and /or residential buildings on it. It is the location of ongoing community complaints regarding public drinking, loud noise, and fights. This particular area is also significant to Officers due to the high amount of violent and firearm related crime that has taken place near it, including several incidents that have occurred in the immediate vicinity of the traffic stop. Officers Adams, Harrington, and O'Toole have all personally responded to several of these incidents of violence. Note the following:

Additionally, Officers were aware that a roadside memorial for one of the recent Orlando Street homicide victims, located directly across from the traffic stop, had just been vandalized, further adding to tensions in the area.

Due to the suspect abruptly exiting the car, his nervous behavior inside the vehicle, and his inability to logically explain his actions, combined with Officers' direct knowledge on ongoing violent crime in the area, and specifically crime involving firearms, Officers believed that the suspect was armed and dangerous and issued an exit order.

Officer Adams instructed the suspect to exit the vehicle and opened the driver's side door. As the suspect began to step out of the vehicle, Officer O'Toole observed what he immediately knew to be a black handgun wedged between the left lower side of the driver's seat and the frame of the driver's side door. Officer O'Toole alerted Officers Adams and Harrington to the presence of the firearm while at the same time pulling the suspect out of the vehicle and away from the gun. The suspect was then handcuffed without further incident.

Officers notified BPD Operations (Channel 3). The C900 (Sgt. Devito) and C805 (Det. McElmoyle) responded and processed the scene.

The firearm was found to be a black, unloaded, Glock 9mm handgun (Serial #BDKL527). A magazine was partially inserted but not secured in the magazine well. The magazine contained seventeen (17) 9mm cartridges with the marking "IK-22." The magazine had a capacity to hold eighteen (18) rounds.

The C111D (Officers O'Connor and Ryan) transported the suspect back to District B-3 for booking.

The suspect requested his wallet be left inside the vehicle. Due to the suspect's vehicle blocking a driveway and for the safekeeping of his wallet and other personal items, a tow was requested. Akiki and Sons towed the vehicle from the scene (#4279).

In addition to all passenger windows and rear windshield, the vehicle's front windshield was also found to be tinted, preventing sunlight from entering and making it extremely difficult to see inside the vehicle. Officer O'Toole used a Laser Labs Inc. tint meter (Enforcer II, Model 1000) to measure the tint of the windows. The front driver's side window and rear driver's side window measured 32%. The legal tint in Massachusetts is 35%.

### NARRATIVE

This supplemental is to provide information not previously reported in the original incident narrative.

After the firearm was initially recovered, the suspect (Ricardo Hamilton) was detained in handcuffs and Officer Harrington demanded his license to carry. The suspect responded by shaking his head left to right to indicate he did not have one.

Officer Adams then read the suspect his Miranda rights from a card carried on his person. No further questioning of the suspect took place on scene.
