NARRATIVE

Within the last 72 hours, members of the Citywide Drug Control Unit, under the direct supervision of the V984 (Sgt. Det. Kenneth Conley), conducted a "Buy / Walk" controlled purchase of drugs while utilizing a Boston Police Under Cover Officer. The amount of drugs and the location of the controlled purchase are being purposely omitted to protect the integrity of this investigation. The drugs were seized by officers and stored in the C-11 Drug Locker. These drugs were logged into the C-11 Drug Book (11-0004) on page 073. Sgt. Det. Conley conducted a field test of said substance using the Thermo Scientific TruNarc machine with a positive result for the presence of Fentanyl. Scan #824. Investigation is on-going.

NARRATIVE

This supplemental report is being authored to identify James Thewell-Mullen ([REDACTED]) as the person who sold Fentanyl to an undercover officer on April 4th, 2023.

As part of an active and on-going fatal overdose investigation, members of the Citywide Drug Control Unit, as well as the District E-13 Drug Control Unit, positively identified James Thelwell-Mullen (DOB [REDACTED]) as a drug dealer in the Mattapan Area of the City of Boston. Throughout various and clandestine tactics, members of the Drug Control Unit were able to utilize an under-cover police officer to contact James Thelwell-Mullen and arrange a date/time to purchase Fentanyl. This undercover officer (herein referred to as UC) was able to speak to an individual believed to be James Thelwell-Mullen and facilitate a meet location to purchase Fentanyl.

Under the direct supervision of Sgt Det Conley (V984), members of the Drug Control Unit launched operation "RED EYES". Throughout this investigation, officers observed James Thelwell-Mullen, on several occasions, come and go from 59A Old Morton Street, Mattapan Massachusetts. The UC contacted James Thelwell-Mullen, via cell phone, this number which will be purposely omitted from this incident report to protect the integrity of this investigation, to purchase Fentanyl from Thelwell-Mullen.

Once a location and price were agreed upon, members of the Drug Control Unit established surveillance on Thelwell-Mullen and his home (59A Old Morton Street). The UC was provided Boston Police issued "Buy Money", in random denominations which were photographed prior to the controlled buy for record keeping purposes. Once contact was made between the UC and the target, officers observed an individual who multiple officers observed and identified James Thelwell-Mullen leave 59A Old Morton Street and travel towards the meet location. Officers observed an interaction between the UC and Thelwell-Mullen, consistent with a street level drug transaction. Officers then observed the individuals separate, and travel in opposite directions. Once safe, the UC was secured by officers and debriefed.

The details of the transaction will purposely be omitted to protect the investigation, however the UC, as well as several other officers assigned to the Drug Control Unit, positively identified James Thelwell-Mullen as the suspect who sold the UC Fentanyl on. The UC stated that the UC provided James Thelwell-Mullen with Boston Police issued "Buy Money" in exchange for a quantity of Fentanyl. The suspected Fentanyl was field tested by Sgt Det. Conley using a Thermo Scientific TruNarc machine which returned a positive result for Fentanyl. Scan # 824

As a result of this incident, officers believe there is probable cause to charge James Thelwell-Mullen ([REDACTED]), SSN [REDACTED]) with Distribution Class A, Fentanyl.

An arrest warrant will be sought out of Dorchester District Court for James Thelwell-Mullen [REDACTED].

Operation "Red Eyes" Investigation is ongoing.

About 1:50PM on Friday, April 28th 2023, members of the CWDCU, along with the District E-13 DCU, effected the on-site WARRANT ARREST of James THELWELL-MULLEN (DOB [REDACTED]), at the corner of Old Morton Street and River Street, Dorchester MA.

As part of an on-going investigation, members of the DCU were aware of several active warrants for the arrest of THELWELL-MULLEN.

THELWELL-MULLEN had a straight warrant (DOCKET #2307CR001049) issued on 04/28/2023 out of Dorchester District Court by the Honorable Judge Miller. The charges were for Distribution Class A; Fentanyl.

The suspect was placed under arrest without incident and transported back to District B-3 by the C113D (Cox /Meaney).

Warrant unit notified via fax.

Several other warrants cleared under original incident numbers.

NARRATIVE

In January of 2023, officers assigned to the City Wide Drug Control Unit began an investigation into a Fatal Overdose (See I232000655). Over the course of this investigation, James Michael Thelwell-Mullen was identified as an individual conducting the sale of illegal narcotics, specifically fentanyl, in the City of Boston. Over the course of the last four months, Officers assigned to the DCU commenced Operation "Red Eyes" utilizing Boston Police Under Cover Officers (UC). This operation resulted in the four successfully purchases of fentanyl from the person known to officers as James Michael Thelwell-Mullen. Officers sought and received two search warrants for the Home and Person of James Michael Thelwell-Mullen on April 26th, 2023. Additionally officers sought and received four warrants for the arrest of James Michael Thelwell-Mullen for Distribution of Class A (Fentanyl) on the morning of April 28th, 2023.

On Friday April 28th, 2023 at around 1:50 PM Members of the City Wide Drug control Unit and E-13 Drug Control Unit (DCU) assisted by Boston Police Detectives assigned to the ATF as well as ATF Agent John Christensen placed James Michael Thelwell-Mullen ([REDACTED]) under arrest for four active straight warrants issued out of Dorchester District

Court, (see 232025975, 232026272, 232028637, and 232031891). Additionally, officers had in their possession a Search Warrant for the Body of James Michael Thelwell Mullen (Docket **2807SW99** see **232032786**) as well as a search warrant of 59A Old Morton Street, Mattapan (Docket **2807SW98**). The aforementioned warrants were authored by Officer William Hull and reviewed by Sergeant Detective Kenneth Conley as well as Suffolk Superior Court ADA Frankie Leone. The warrants were additionally reviewed and signed by Assistant Clerk Magistrate Amanda Ward of Dorchester District Court.

Armed with four straight warrants for the arrest of James Michael Thelwell-Mullen as well as a search warrant of his body and search warrant of his home (59A Old Morton Street, Mattapan), officers observed James Michael Thelwell-Mullen leave his home and enter Massachusetts Registration [REDACTED], a black 2008 Lexus IS250. Members of the DCU and ATF operating soft cars wearing outer vest carriers reading "Boston Police" and "ATF" with badges clearly displayed on their outermost garment did stop Thelwell-Mullen in the area of River Street and Old Morton Street without incident.

Thelwell-Mullen was removed from the vehicle, by Detectives Bernier, Detective Moynihan, and Officer Neely and placed into handcuffs by Detective Bernier, Officer Hull provided Thelwell-Mullen with his Miranda Warning, to which he stated that he understood. Officers explained to Thelwell-Mullen that they had multiple arrest warrants for him, and that they additionally had a search warrant for his person, as well as his home. Officers inquired as to who else was in the home, to which Thelwell-Mullen stated the home was empty with the exception of his cat. Sgt. Det. Conley did retrieve a set of keys from the back-right pocket of Thelwell-Mullen and inquired as to whether or not the keys would unlock the front door of 59A Old Morton, to which Thelwell-Mullen explained that the "red" key on the keychain opened the door. The passenger of the vehicle was identified as [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]).

[REDACTED] was removed from the vehicle and Mirandized by Detective B. England to which she stated that she understood. Det. England inquired who Thelwell-Mullen was to her, to which she stated he was [REDACTED]. Det. England explained to [REDACTED] that they had a search warrant for the home and inquired if she had any property within the home, to which she stated that she had clothing in the second-floor bedroom. Det. England provided [REDACTED] with her property (Cell phone, coach bag, Vape Pen, and Target Bag containing her work uniform) from MA Reg. [REDACTED] before [REDACTED] left the area.

MA Reg. [REDACTED] was parked and secured in a legal parking spot in the area of 59 Old Morton Street. The keys would later be left in the home of 59A Old Morton Street.

Officers assigned to the DCU and ATF successfully made peaceful entry into 59A Old Morton Street where officers presented Thelwell-Mullen with a search warrant for his person (Docket 2807SW99) and a search warrant for his home (Docket 2807SW98). Officers inquired as to whether or not Thelwell-Mullen had any drugs on his person, to which he stated he did not, officers further inquired if Thelwell-Mullen had any drugs in his home to which he acknowledged having a small amount of fentanyl in his home and further directed officer's attention to a wooden cabinet located in the main living area on the first floor stating that the fentanyl was in the top center drawer.

Officers assigned to the DCU and ATF conducted a search of 59A Old Morton Street, Mattapan and recovered and seized the following items of evidentiary value:

- 1) 1 Plastic Bag of Fentanyl (Hull)
- 2) Black Firearm Safe (England)
- 3) 30 Rounds of .45 Ammo (Christianson)

Officers did locate 1 gas powered motorcycle in the homes kitchen which was not reported stolen at this time. Officers spoke to Sgt. Det. McDougall of the Auto Theft Task Force, and for safety reasons and safe keeping, the decision was made to have the motorcycle towed (Akiki & Sons Slip 3902). Tow Line Notified (Raye).

Sgt. Det. Conley did conduct a Thermal Scientific TruNarc test of the drugs, which tested positive for fentanyl (Scan 842).

In addition to the four straight warrants issued out of Dorchester District Court, James Michael Thelwell-Mullen will be charged with the following:

NARRATIVE

In January of 2023, officers assigned to the City Wide Drug Control Unit began an investigation into a Fatal Overdose (See I232000655). Over the course of this investigation, James Michael Thelwell-Mullen was identified as an individual conducting the sale of illegal narcotics, specifically fentanyl, in the City of Boston. Over the course of the last four months, Officers assigned to the DCU commenced Operation "Red Eyes" utilizing Boston Police Under Cover Officers (UC). This operation resulted in the four successfully purchases of fentanyl from the person known to officers as James Michael Thelwell-Mullen. Officers sought and received two search warrants for the Home and Person of James Michael Thelwell-Mullen on April 26th, 2023. Additionally officers sought and received four warrants for the arrest of James Michael Thelwell-Mullen for Distribution of Class A (Fentanyl) on the morning of April 28th, 2023.

On Friday April 28th, 2023 at around 1:50 PM Members of the City Wide Drug control Unit and E-13 Drug Control Unit (DCU) assisted by Boston Police Detectives assigned to the ATF as well as ATF Agent John Christensen placed James Michael Thelwell-Mullen ([REDACTED]) under arrest for four active straight warrants issued out of Dorchester District

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Court, (see 232025975, 232026272, 232028637, and 232031891). Additionally, officers had in their possession a Search Warrant for the Body of James Michael Thelwell Mullen (Docket **2807SW99**) as well as a search warrant of 59A Old Morton Street, Mattapan (Docket **2807SW98** see **I232032728**). The aforementioned warrants were authored by Officer William Hull and reviewed by Sergeant Detective Kenneth Conley as well as Suffolk Superior Court ADA Frankie Leone. The warrants were additionally reviewed and signed by Assistant Clerk Magistrate Amanda Ward of Dorchester District Court.

Armed with four straight warrants for the arrest of James Michael Thelwell-Mullen as well as a search warrant of his body and search warrant of his home (59A Old Morton Street, Mattapan), officers observed James Michael Thelwell-Mullen leave his home and enter Massachusetts Registration [REDACTED], a black 2008 Lexus IS250. Members of the DCU and ATF operating soft cars wearing outer vest carriers reading "Boston Police" and "ATF" with badges clearly displayed on their outermost garment did stop Thelwell-Mullen in the area of River Street and Old Morton Street without incident.

Thelwell-Mullen was removed from the vehicle, by Detectives Bernier, Detective Moynihan, and Officer Neely and placed into handcuffs by Detective Bernier, Officer Hull provided Thelwell-Mullen with his Miranda Warning, to which he stated that he understood. Officers explained to Thelwell-Mullen that they had multiple arrest warrants for him, and that they additionally had a search warrant for his person, as well as his home. Officers inquired as to who else was in the home, to which Thelwell-Mullen stated the home was empty with the exception of his cat. Sgt. Det. Conley did retrieve a set of keys from the back-right pocket of Thelwell-Mullen and inquired as to whether or not the keys would unlock the front door of 59A Old Morton, to which Thelwell-Mullen explained that the "red" key on the keychain opened the door. The passenger of the vehicle was identified as [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]).

[REDACTED] was removed from the vehicle and Mirandized by Detective B. England to which she stated that she understood. Det. England inquired who Thelwell-Mullen was to her, to which she stated he was [REDACTED]. Det. England explained to [REDACTED] that they had a search warrant for the home and inquired if she had any property within the home, to which she stated that she had clothing in the second-floor bedroom. Det. England provided Ms. Tran with her property (Cell phone, coach bag, Vape Pen, and Target Bag containing her work uniform) from MA Reg. [REDACTED] before [REDACTED] left the area.

MA Reg. [REDACTED] was parked and secured in a legal parking spot in the area of 59 Old Morton Street. The keys would later be left in the home of 59A Old Morton Street.

Officers assigned to the DCU and ATF successfully made peaceful entry into 59A Old Morton Street where officers presented Thelwell-Mullen with a search warrant for his person (Docket 2807SW99) and a search warrant for his home (Docket 2807SW98). Officers inquired as to whether or not Thelwell-Mullen had any drugs on his person, to which he stated he did not, officers further inquired if Thelwell-Mullen had any drugs in his home to which he acknowledged having a small amount of fentanyl in his home and further directed officer's attention to a wooden cabinet stating that the fentanyl was in the top center drawer.

Officer Hull conducted a search of James Michael Thelwell-Mullen Docket 2807SW99 and recovered the following items

One Flipper Zero

Additional, officers seized one key to the front door of 59A Old Morton Street, Mattapan and one Apple iPhone which had been taken from the person of Thelwell-Mullen during the initial stop.

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It should be noted that Sgt. Det. Conley did contact 617-579-6605 utilizing his department issued cell phone. Upon placing the phone call, the phone seized from the person of Thelwell-Mullen began to ring. Incoming phone call was photographed by PO Hull.

No other items of evidentiary value were recovered.

Search Warrant Docket **2807SW99** to be returned to Dorchester District Court.

Thelwell-Mullen was transported to District B3 by C113D (Cox / Meaney) where he was booked without incident.

No further criminal charges will be sought as a result of the execution of the body search warrant.

Wallet and miscellaneous keys taken from the person of James Michael Thelwell-Mullen by officer Hull was returned to the property of Mr. Thelwell-Mullen.
